

Committee Descriptions

Baptismal Committee - Assists the pastor and the new members in preparing for the ordinance of baptism.

Bereavement Committee - Assesses and ministers to physical needs resulting from the death of a church member.

Children's Ministry Committee - Assists the Minister of Children in providing programs and activities for children grades K through five.

Chrismon Committee - Decorates the Worship Center, foyer, and Family Life Center for religious celebrations.

Church History Committee - Maintains historical data of Yates Baptist Church.

Denominational Relations Committee - Encourages active participation in denominational life and makes available to the congregation updated information on denominational issues.

Extension Committee - Visits and/or calls Yates Baptist Church shut-ins.

Flower Committee - Ensures that proper floral arrangements are in place on Sunday mornings and on other special occasions.

Hospitality Committee - Plans and coordinates special events to mark significant milestones in the life of the Church.

Finance Committee - Leads and encourages the Church in stewardship matters, prepares and submits an annual budget to the Church for approval, and provides oversight of expenses during the year.

House and Grounds Committee - Maintains and improves the buildings and grounds of the Church or arranges for the work to be done by qualified individuals or companies.

Nominating Committee - Recommends and contacts persons to fill all lay leadership positions in the Church, including teachers, mission and choir leaders, extended session workers, and committee members.

Personnel Committee - Establishes and administers church personnel policies and practices.

Weekday Early Education Committee - Oversees the operation of the Yates Baptist CDC and updates the Church regularly on its status.

Committee Descriptions – cont'd

Kitchen Committee - Supervises the use of the Family Life Center kitchen and oversees the operation of the Wednesday family night meal.

Lord's Supper Committee - Prepares the elements needed for the Lord's Supper and cleans up following the service.

Media Committee - Acquires and makes accessible various media resources including books, audio, and video media.

Music Committee - Assists the Minister of Music in implementing the music ministry of the Church.

Preschool Ministry Committee – Assists the Minister of Children in providing programs and activities for preschoolers, ages birth through five years old.

Recreation Committee - Plans and promotes leisure activities geared toward promoting fellowship and the building of relationships among the church family.

Senior Adult Committee - Assists the Minister of Adult Discipleship in planning, promoting, and implementing senior adult recreation and fellowship.

Worship Away Committee - Distributes worship service recordings to shut-in members of the Church.

Transportation Committee - Oversees the maintenance and operation of all church-owned vehicles.

Usher Committee - Greets members and guests preceding worship and receives the offering during the service.

Youth Advisory Committee - Serves as an advisory committee to the Minister of Youth and Recreation and helps plan the programs and ministries for the youth.
